

Q-FOCUSER-BSTEELTRACK INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Installation of the Q-Focuser-BSteelTrack bracket is straightforward and requires only a few simple steps.

Tools needed: 4mm hex key, 2.5mm hex key, 1.5mm hex key (not provided)

Q-Focuser version note: Since this bracket attaches the Q-Focuser to the coarse focus side of the focuser, if using the High Precision Q-Focuser it may be necessary to use the external 12v power source for added torque.

STEP 1

- Rotate the scope or focuser so that the focuser pinion shaft is on top. Remove the single black coarse focus knob from the left side of the focuser.
- Remove the silver brake knob, and three black placeholder screws on the bottom of the focuser.





- Locate included (3) M6x12mm button head screws.
- Secure the bracket to the focuser with all three screws using the M4 hex key.
- Replace the silver brake knob.

STEP 2

• Place the coupler on the Q-Focuser pinion shaft and secure with two set screws using the 1.5mm hex key. Do NOT overtighten the set screws.

STEP 3

- Rotate the focuser so that the flat on the focuser pinion shaft matches the flat in the coupler. Slide the Q-Focuser and coupler onto the focuser pinion shaft.
- Secure the Q-Focuser to the bracket with the QHY supplied M3 bolts.
- Secure the coupler onto the focuser pinion shaft by tightening the set screws using the 1.5mm hex key. Do NOT overtighten the screws.
